

鄭冬是我們資助多年的學生梁浩然的母親,過去幾年的接觸,發現了她對孩子康復教育的委身與成長為老師的潛力,透過 YY的鼓勵栽培,她信了主,更願意接受彩虹的助學計劃,現在全職培訓,日後投入服務。

11/12月

2020年的聖誕捐贈,是我們接獲捐款最多的一年,遠遠超過了所定的目標!因此,四位殘障孩子有機會接受我們的緊急醫療基金的救助,兩位接受了眼睛手術,一位做了緊急透析治療,另一位是新生兒康復治療,他們情況穩定,在康復之中。 2020實在是非常不容易的一年;瘟疫是一場災難,然而在最絕望的災難面前,也最能展現人類最高貴的情操,特別是屬神 的子民。

懷著這樣的信念,我們確知深信,疫情也許持續,但絕不能越過上帝的大能。在病毒面前,透過國內殘障群體的經歷,我 們見證了主的真實,看到了上帝的榮光。





Another great news was our field worker YY got married in late September. In 2017, YY was called by God to join RM to support teachers and serve disabled children and their parents in the field. She has been growing in the Lord and becoming everyone's blessing. We praise God for this new family established in the love of God. YY is currently settled in Shenyang and continues to serve and help expand our ministry among local disability groups.

October

Zheng Dong is the mother of Liang Haoran, a student we've sponsored for many years. Over the past few years during our field visits, we found she had a commitment to children's rehabilitative education and the potential to be a good teacher. Through YY's support and encouragement, she became a Christian, got baptized, and joined RM's sponsorship program for teacher training.

November/December

Donations for the 2020 Christmas Giving far exceeded our target and set a new RM record! As a result, 4 additional disabled children were able to receive financial assistance from our emergency fund to meet their medical needs. Two underwent eye surgery, 1 received emergency dialysis treatment, and a newborn baby was able to receive PT. The 4 are on their way to full recovery.

2020 was a very difficult year for everyone. COVID-19 caused many terrible calamities; but in the face of the most desperate situations, it also brought out the most noble in mankind, especially in the children of God.

With this conviction, we are convinced that even if the pandemic continues to spread, it will not surpass the eternal power of God. We've witnessed His love upon those we serve in the field and seen His glory shine upon them.

1-3月

我們收到了來自視障大學生的暖心問候,他們因為疫情都不能回校,只可以留住家中上網課。當他們聽說美國的疫情嚴重時,就各自從自己的老家拍攝了短短的視頻,向我們這些一直支持關愛著他們的彩虹叔叔阿姨 指來了深切的叮嚀與祝福!

5/6月

自閉症中心的老師們經過一段時間在網上輔導家長與學生,終於獲准回校備課。

在西雅圖 部的同工們,因為社交隔離而不得不取消了年度籌款晚宴,卻突發奇想,別具創意地展開了雨場「星光車影」戶外募款晚會的籌備工作。

January-March

Our ministry partner Angel Home in Guangxi ended its services in CZ, causing us to close out our 3 years of service to children with cerebral palsy. But we are grateful we can still continue to support some through their caregivers.

The visually impaired students at CCU and BMU went back to their hometowns to celebrate the Spring Festival. The children at the CCAC also had a happy spring break.

Unexpectedly, before the Spring Festival arrived, all festivities had to be cancelled due to the rapidly spreading pandemic.

When we were still trying hard to find ways to support our sponsored children, the epidemic was slowly spreading in China. Then everyone was caught off guard by COVID-19 here in the States. Before long, we were social distancing, wearing masks and using hand sanitizers.

April

We received warm greetings from visually impaired college students who were unable to return to school and could only participate in online classes at home. When they heard about the outbreak in the United States, they made a short video from wherever they were and sent touching greetings and blessings to us.

May/June

After a few months of shutdown in their cities CCAC teachers were allowed to return to school and prepare to teach in person again.

On the other hand, RM at the Seattle headquarters had to cancel its annual fundraising dinner events due to social distancing. But on a whim we creatively launched preparations for two "Cars Under the Stars" outdoor fundraising events to serve the same purpose.

7月

因為疫情持續,自閉症中心的學生都不能復課;沒有學費的收入,但校址的租金、老師的薪資並其他開銷仍需支付,加上被房東逼遷,中心的財務與日常運作都出現了前所未有的危機。作為合作夥伴,彩虹工程對於中心的困境感到責無旁貸,幾度撥款資助,讓老師們及時收到薪資解決生活問題,中心也有資源支付其他開銷及找到地點適中的校址,渡過重重危機。 8月

彩虹工程的十五週年慶祝在兩次戶外籌款晚會中如期舉行,由於經驗與物資不足,充滿挑戰,但「彩虹盡處見主恩」,一切 圓滿順利,特別感謝在影音/直播及其他方面全力支持幫助我們的義工,並親臨現場或透過直播參與活動的朋友和弟兄姊 妹。

9月

視障大學生及自閉症的孩子們紛紛回校復課。

透過彩虹助學計劃接受資助的同學包括:視障大學或研究生 15人,高中同學 3人,自閉症的孩子 5人。 我們國內的同工YY 在九月下旬舉行婚禮;自2017年 YY 蒙召獻身,加入彩虹團隊,支援老師、服事殘障孩子及他們的家長,幾年來成為了大家的祝福,她自己的生命也不斷成長,感謝主為她預備了敬 的弟兄組織愛主的家庭。婚後YY 定居瀋陽,繼續努力為主拓展當地殘障群體的事工。

July

Because of the pandemic, CCAC received no tuition from their students for almost a year because schools were closed. However, the rent for the school site, teachers' salaries and other expenses still needed to be paid, and the landlord of the school forced it to relocate. CCAC was facing an unprecedented crisis. As a ministry partner, RM felt duty-bound to help CCAC. Several grants were sent to help pay bills and, most importantly, provide teachers their salaries. We also provided resources for CCAC to find a new school site in a more accessible location.

August

RM's 15th anniversary celebrations at the two outdoor fundraising events were held as scheduled. Due to our lack of experience and equipment, there were many challenges. However, just like our theme "God's Grace Beyond the Rainbow," everything went smoothly. We give thanks to God and for everyone's support -- in audiovisual and live broadcasting, in volunteering, and by joining us at the site or through the broadcast, participating in different activities.

September

Visually impaired college students and children on the autism spectrum returned to in-person classes. Students in our Sponsorship Program included 15 visually impaired students in 3 different universities, 3 high school students, and 5 children in the autism center.
